Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended March 31, 2012 (Unaudited)

1. Purpose of Organization

Red River Nordic Ski Club Inc ("RRN Inc.") is a non-profit sports organization based in Winnipeg, Manitoba, operating Nordic ski and biathlon programs. RRN Inc operates a series of programs to train children and adults to ski, runs specific ski racing programs for young athletes with the skills and desire to improve their skiing and racing abilities, runs biathlon training programs, and runs a series of ski races, biathlon races and ski-related events throughout the winter. RRN Inc. is incorporated in Manitoba as a not-for-profit organization.

RRN Inc. earns most of its revenue from membership fees paid directly by the members, supplemented through grants and fundraising activities, and expends it funds on ski-related, biathlon-related and club activities.

RRN Inc. operates under the name of Red River Nordic Ski and Biathlon Club.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Reporting

The financial statements of RRN Inc. are based on a modified form of non-profit accounting and fund accounting guidelines, and are prepared for the use of the membership in the management of the organization. They do not necessarily follow all aspects of generally accepted accounting principles.

Revenue Recognition

Membership fee revenues, program registration fee revenues, and event fee revenues are all received and related expenditures are incurred in the same fiscal year. No such revenues and matching expenditures are incurred in different fiscal years.

Equipment (Capital Assets)

Equipment is recorded at cost and depreciated over the estimated life of the asset. Any equipment with a purchase cost of less than \$5000 is expensed in year. Assets purchased greater than \$5000, generally race electronics, are amortized over the estimated useful life of 3 years. All such assets at the end of year are fully depreciated. RRN Inc. owns no building or land.

Contributed Services

Volunteers contribute thousands of hours annually to assist with events, training, club organization and other related activities. Sport Manitoba, through the Cross Country Ski Association of Manitoba ("CCSAM") and Biathlon Manitoba, provide selected administrative services, race coordination services, meeting space, and significant other services that vary from year to year. Because of the difficulty in determining the value, contributed services are not recognized in the financial statements.

2. Significant Accounting Policies (continued)

Fund Accounting

In order to ensure observance of limitations and restrictions placed on the use of certain financial resources, the accounts of RRN Inc. are maintained in accordance with the principles of fund accounting. The funds restricted in use to certain race team and biathlon activities have been classified into separate "Race Team" and "Biathlon" funds. These funds may only be utilized in accordance with the purposes established by RRN Inc. members tasked with fundraising and utilization of such funds, and are in contrast with the unrestricted "General Fund" over which the Board retains full control to use in achieving its purposes. Restricted gifts, grants, and other restricted resources are accounted for in the appropriate restricted funds. Revenues from current restricted funds are recognized when expenditures are incurred for current operating purposes. The excess of restricted receipts over amounts expended for restricted purposes is recognized as a fund balance addition to current restricted funds.

3. Change in Accounting Presentation

In prior years, RRN Inc. presented the revenues and expenditures from its programs and events separately on the financial statements. For these financial statements, RRN Inc. has presented the revenues and expenditures as net, to reflect the manner in which the programs and events are run as distinct activities, and to give a fairer presentation of the financial results of each program and event.

This change in accounting presentation did not give rise to any adjustments to the opening balances or equity, although prior comparative figures and presentation of the previous year's information have been restated to be consistent with the current year presentation.

4. Program Revenues and Expenditures

Program revenues are shown net of directly related program expenditures. Additional details are shown below:

6. Grants

RRN Inc. applies for and receives generous grants from the CCSAM to support coaching provided to young cross country ski athletes and for ongoing development of club programs. These grants are listed within the financial statements or related notes and are recorded when notifications are received from CCSAM regarding these grants.

RRN Inc. also receives grants from other parties based on successful grant applications and other community initiatives. These grants are listed within the financial statements or related notes and are recorded when RRN Inc. feels comfortable that all requirements of the grant have been fulfilled and collection is reasonably certain.

There are no outstanding grants receivable at the end of the fiscal year.

7. Bingo Liability

Members of RRN Inc. are given the opportunity by CCSAM to work at Sport Manitoba bingos, and Sport Manitoba provides funding to RRN Inc. in exchange for volunteer activities provided at the bingos. For certain bingos, RRN Inc. allows those members who volunteer at Sport Manitoba bingos to apply credits earned at bingos against registration fees and other ski-related expenses. Amounts received from CCSAM and Sport Manitoba are treated as liabilities until credits are requested by the members or payout is initiated by the Board.
